The UTAC Lifeline and Link-Up programs are funded entirely through voluntary donations.

These programs work with PCs for People and the federally-funded Lifeline program to help eligible people and families connect to telephone and internet services. Through these partnerships, low-cost electronic devices, internet, and telephone services are made available to people who would otherwise not be able to afford them.
